## Southampton, England



Located in the picturesque English county of Hampshire, Southampton is a vibrant waterfront city, serviced by direct trains to London, an airport, and an international cruise terminal. Explore the city's maritime heritage and links to RMS Titanic in the Sea City Museum, see contemporary British art in the Cultural Quarter, or walk the medieval walls in the Old Town, paying a visit to the Tudor House and Garden.

## Lisbon, Portugal

A brief stroll along the streets that wind around Lisbon is enough to appreciate the city's history. Lisbon, one of the oldest cities in the world, traces its origins to 1200 BC. Gothic towers and decadent domes burst from a sea of red-tiled buildings, and at ground level there are elegant shops, graceful palacios and ancient ruins. Lively marketplaces and bountiful pastelarias feed the city, while Lisbon's many cool fountains and leafy parks provide shade for locals and visitors.



## Cadiz, Spain



Historic, mysterious, and romantic, the Spanish city of Cádiz is unlike any other. Founded around 1100 BC, it's generally accepted as the oldest, continuously inhabited settlement in Europe. You'll find a complex warren of streets, bustling bars, and pretty beaches. Not only that, but the port is packed with historic sites, monuments, and an excellent museum of art and archaeology. You may well find it difficult to decide what to do or where to go first!

# Valencia, Spain

One of the busiest seaports in Europe, Valencia welcomes thousands of guests each year who seek to explore its wonderful delights. Valencia Port is located in the heart of the Valencia region and is just a short walk south of swaying palm trees, golden shores, and glistening blue seas. As you sail into port, be sure to appreciate the sights, sounds, and smells that introduce you to the ancient city.



# Barcelona, Spain

## La Coruña, Spain



Nestled along the northwest coast of Spain, La Coruna is a relatively hidden gem compared to cities such as Madrid or Barcelona, yet it offers an unmistakably traditional and understated Spanish charm. Renowned for its artistic history and glass balconies, a port call here offers the chance to follow in the footsteps of Picasso, drink in the dramatically beautiful coastline, and stroll through historic streets peppered with awe-inspiring architectural wonders.
