St Thomas

St. Thomas is an island of towering cliffs and mangrove swamps. It is also the home to heart-shaped Magens Bay, which is undoubtedly one of the most pristine and beautiful of all the Caribbean beaches. In Charlotte Amalie, named after a Danish princess, you'll find Fort Christian and Blackbeard Castle, claimed to have been the infamous pirate's lookout. The duty-free stores now carry the bounty.



St. Maarten

Perched on a narrow strip of land between the crystal clear Caribbean Sea and the Great Salt Pond, the Caribbean gem of St. Maarten is a fabulous setting for a wide array of things to see and experience. Stroll along the inland salt lake, or head for the gorgeous city beach. Search the quaint clothes boutiques, or browse the stores for duty-free bargains. The choice is yours. With its striking white churches amongst groves of swaying coconut trees, St. Maarten is one of the Caribbean's most idyllic and unspoiled locations.



San Juan

San Juan - Puerto Rico welcomes you with lovely panoramic views of the old and new city of San Juan. In Old Town you'll see historic landmarks built by the Spaniards between 1539 and 1771. Take photos and walk along the grounds of the oldest Spanish fort in the New World - Fort San Felipe del Morro - built in 1539 to guard the entrance and defend the harbor of San Juan Bay. See the Condado District, famous for its striking beaches, upscale hotels and casinos. Visit the only tropical rain forest in US territory -- the El Yunque Rain Forest. This natural treasure exhibits jungle-like vegetation, impressive waterfalls and cool, fresh air.



Grand Turk



Grand Turk is the largest of the Turks Islands and is home to historic sites, stunning beaches and colorful marine life. Discover the island's British and Bermuda roots while touring Cockburn Town where you can learn about the island's old sea salt industry and see the popular Grand Turk Lighthouse – the only lighthouse in the Turks and Caicos. Or enjoy a scenic boat ride over to nearby Gibbs Cay and splash around with the wild stingrays that like to gather in the pristine calm waters surrounding the island.
