Elegant neighborhoods such as Palermo, home to many embassies and the capital's wealthier population, as well as Recoleta - known for its parks, restaurants and nightlife, and the modern: Puerto Madero, Buenos Aires old port which has been completely renovated with many restaurants and shops, just at the city's edge. Parks such as Lezama, Tres de Febrero and the Ecological Reserve. We will also visit financial and commercial areas and the soccer stadium.
